

**CITY MANAGER'S EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 17-003  
AMENDMENT TO CITY OF DES MOINES MARINA PAY PARKING  
NON-RESIDENT FEE**

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES** relating to Marina Pay Parking and amending Paragraph II of Executive Order No. 17-002 by reducing the Non-Resident Pay Parking fee.

**RECITALS**

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager set the fees for Marina Pay Parking in Executive Order No. 17-002, and

**WHEREAS**, since that time, City staff has been monitoring the number of purchased annual passes for residents and non-residents, and

**WHEREAS**, in order to balance the costs of Pay Parking Passes for non-residents compared to residents, seeking to effectively determine the elasticity of demand, the City Manager finds that it is appropriate to reduce the annual cost of non-resident passes ; now therefore,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** as follows:

Paragraph II of Executive Order No. 17-002, dated August 24, 2017, is amended as follows:

**II. Non-Resident Pay Parking Pass**

Non-residents may purchase an annual Parking Pass at the Marina Office for \$60. Non-residents have access to the North, South, and Beach Park lots between 5:00 am and 10:00 pm (access cards will not work after 10:00 pm). The frequent user Pass is similar to an access card or Orca Card and has a built-in computer chip.
