2. Citywide Radar Feedback Sign Update: Transportation and Engineering Services Manager, Andrew Merges went over the updated selected permanent locations for radar feedback sign installation in 2019.
3. 2019 Arterial Paving Program Update: Transportation and Engineering Services Manager, Andrew Merges reviewed current efforts partnering with various franchise utilities to maximize pavement funding available. The City is currently working with Highline Water District in effort to develop a joint AC water main replacement and paving project within the North Hill neighborhood. Lakehaven indicated that their water main replacement project for lower Woodmont neighborhood will be postponed until 2020. Water District #54 indicated that they are pursuing funding options for the 8th Avenue AC water main replacement project, but it appears unlikely that they will be able to proceed with construction in 2019.
