MINUTES

March 27, 2008

Mayor Sheckler called the special meeting of the Des Moines City Council to order at 6:30 p.m. in the City Hall Conference Room, 21630 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue South, #A.

ROLL CALL - Present: Mayor Bob Sheckler, Mayor Pro Tem Dan Sherman, Councilmembers Dave Kaplan, Ed Pina, Carmen Scott, Scott Thomasson and Susan White. Also in attendance were City Manager Tony Piasecki, City Attorney Pat Bosmans, Assistant City Attorney Susan Mahoney, Planning, Building and Public Works Director Grant Fredricks, Harbormaster Joe Dusenbury and Land Use Planner II Jason Sullivan.
