

**CITY MANAGER'S EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 22-002
CITY OF DES MOINES**

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES rescinding the stand-by temporary unemployment status policy established under Executive Order 20-003.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, the United States Department of Public Health and Human Services Secretary Alex Azar declared a public emergency for the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) beginning on January 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines declared a public emergency in March of 2020 due to the Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager is authorized by Des Moines Municipal Code 2.12.100 to promulgate personnel policies and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager through Executive Order 20-003 established a Stand-by Temporary Unemployment Status Policy to remain in effect during the Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on October 20, 2022, the City Council rescinded the City's Emergency Declaration and the City Manager confirmed his intent to rescind Executive Order 20-003 as it is no longer necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDERED** as follows:

- (1) Executive Order 20-003 is hereby **RESCINDED**.
